During our AFL clinics we have learned how to kick, handball and catch.

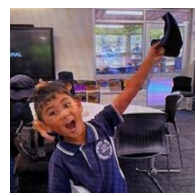

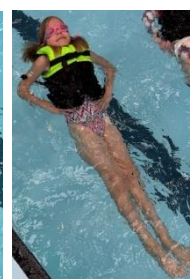
