At Flinders Park Primary School *we strive for excellence together*. In the way we wear our uniform, this means using our school values to:

- Respect the uniform guidelines.
- Take responsibility for ensuring we wear our uniform the agreed manner.
- Be **resilient** when asked to change our uniform to follow the guidelines.

Our Rationale

At Flinders Park Primary School, we take pride in our uniform, as it provides our students with a sense of belonging and connection with our school community.

Our uniform providers a means of easily identifying our students both in the yard and on excursion, providing an important safety measure for our students.

Our uniform is designed to be affordable, appropriate and functional. In the event that you need assistance sourcing secondhand items, speak to our friendly office staff

Our Uniform

Our uniform colours are navy and white. Below is a list of the approved uniform apparel available from the front office:

- Contrasting navy and white polo top with school logo.
- Navy jumper with school logo.
- Navy shorts/skorts/pants.
- Wide brimmed navy hat.

Further Guidelines

Students may wear plain navy or white t-shirts or skivvies under polo shirt.

Plain navy pants, shorts and skorts can be purchased at the front office, however if they purchased elsewhere, they must not have logos or visible branding.

Denim and active wear are not permitted, as they are not a part of the school uniform.

Shorts, skorts and dresses must be long enough for students to participate in a school day in a comfortable and suitable manner ie. Around the knee

Appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times - enclosed shoes that allow students to safely and comfortably participate in activities.

Wide brimmed and legionnaires hats must be navy in colour, caps are not SunSmart and therefore not a part of our school uniform.

Expected Behaviours

We wear our uniform in the way outlined above.

We change our uniform when asked.

We wear our wide brimmed hats in the yard at all times.

Commemorative Jumpers

Year 6 students will have the opportunity to purchase jumpers to commemorate their final year at Flinders Park Primary School.

Make-up, Jewellery and Accessories

Make-up is not appropriate for school and is therefore not permitted.

Jewellery can be a safety concern when it is large and dangly, as it presents a risk of injury to the wearer and others. Therefore, jewellery is limited to: stud earrings, a small watch, a pendant/necklace that can be tucked into the school shirt.

Painted and acrylic nails are not appropriate for school and are therefore not permitted.
